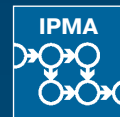

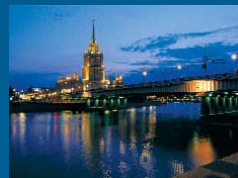

We are looking forward to seeing you in Moscow!

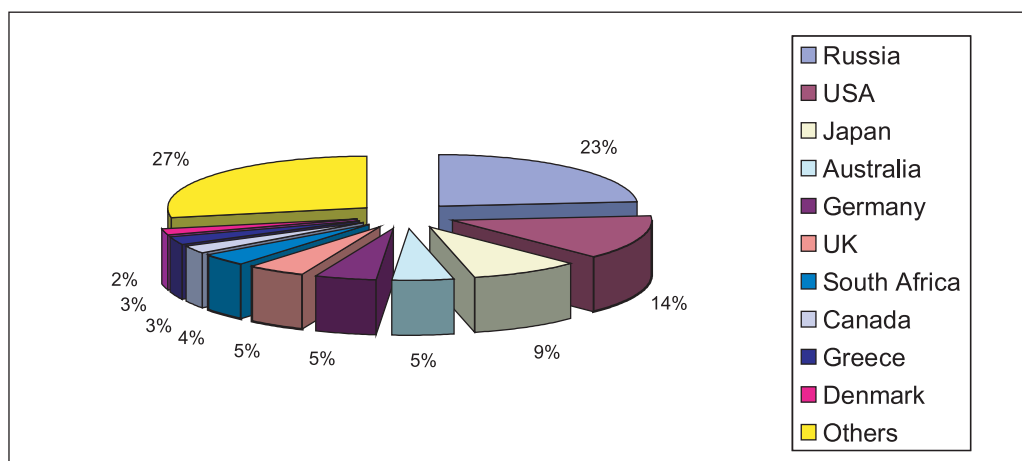

CULTURAL PROGRAM

Moscow - the capital of the Russian Federation - is situated in the center of the European part of Russia, on the banks of the Moskva River. Moscow was founded in 1147 by Prince Yuri Dolgoruky. Moscow is famous for numerous places of interest and architectural monuments. The heart of the capital is the Kremlin which stands on the crest of a hill above the Moskva River. It is flanked by Red Square, which is crowned by the unique and beautiful St. Basil's Cathedral.



The territory of the Kremlin is a huge open-air museum which incorporates a number of unique museum buildings. Those are the world famous Museums of the Moscow Kremlin. Foremost among them is Armoury, the Cathedrals of the Assumption, St. Michael the Archangel and Ordination Church.

Moscow is a city of theaters, among them the world famous Bolshoi Opera and Ballet Theater. There are numerous museums, exhibition halls and art galleries throughout the city, the most famous being the Tretyakov Gallery - a treasure trove of Russian art, ancient Russian icons (11th-17th centuries), graphics and sculptures. Those interested in ancient history may visit churches and cathedrals some dating as early as the 15th century.
