

Certification The term used by professional institutes to recognise individuals who have attained a certain professional standard. Those who have achieved this standard, in accordance with established criteria, are eligible to receive a 'certificate', hence the term "certification".

AIPM Recognition Fee = \$121.00

AIPM Recognition Framework:

- **Affiliates** Individuals who have a strong interest in PM but do not hold recognised PM skills or just thinking about a career in PM.
- **Student** Full-time student (in any discipline) or part-time student in an AIPM endorsed course.
- **Associate Member (AAIPM)** Attained any formal qualification or recognised certification or has had at least 2 years work experience in PM.
- **Member of AIPM (MAIPM)** Attained any formal qualification or recognised certification or has had at least 5 years work experience in PM or attained [RegPM](#) Certification.
- **Fellow Member (FAIPM)** Honour for exceptional contribution to the PM profession.
- **Life Fellow Member (FAIPM)** Highest honour for contribution to the PM profession.
- **RegPM Certification** AIPM's Project Management Certification Program. [RegPM](#) is a competency-based workplace assessment program which requires candidates to compile and provide a logbook of evidence that shows that they are competent at a certain level.

RegPM Certification Framework:

- **CPPP** Supports, assists or contributes to a project
- **CPPM** Plans and manages a project.
- **CPPD** Directs or manages projects/programs/portfolios

Student Membership

AIPM provides a wealth of resources for students to successfully undertake studies to become proficient and competent Project Managers. Upon receipt of their qualification, students will be eligible for recognition as an Associate Member of the AIPM.



To be eligible for student membership you are required to be a full time student enrolled at any faculty or institution. A part time student undertaking a project management course with an AIPM Endorsed Course Provider is also entitled to apply for Student Membership.

Evidence of enrolment from the course provider will need to be provided at the time of application. Visit www.aipm.com.au to apply online for student membership.

Upon completion or receipt of their qualification, part-time student members will be eligible for recognition as an Associate of the AIPM and will need to complete an upgrade membership application form found on the AIPM website. Full-time students need to complete a new online Associate Member application.

What is an Affiliate?

An "Affiliate" is an individual who is interested in being affiliated with the Project Management (PM) industry and desires access to AIPM's resources. They may be an individual who has a strong interest in PM but does not hold recognised PM skills. Formal qualifications or certification or significant work experience in PM is not required. Since an Affiliate is not a "member" of AIPM, they cannot use post nominals or vote at the AGM or in elections.

Affiliates of AIPM can apply for professional recognition as an Associate Member or Member of AIPM upon satisfaction of the relevant criteria.

What is an Associate Member?

An Associate Member (AAIPM) has attained formal qualifications issued by a registered Training Organisation (RTO) to at least AQF Level IV or has received a certification that is recognised by AIPM or can demonstrate at least two years work experience in PM. An Associate Member can use the post nominal AAIPM and can vote at the AGM or in elections.

An Associate Member can apply to become a Member of AIPM by:

- Completing their **RegPM** certification at any level
- Showing they have gained the additional experience or qualification required for member status

What is a Member?

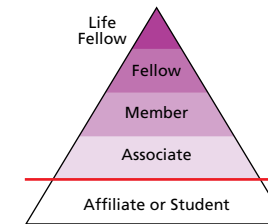
A Member (MAIPM) has demonstrated skills, knowledge and competency to perform in the role of a project team member, project manager or programme director. To be recognised as a Member, the applicant needs to demonstrate a qualification issued by a RTO at least at AQF Level IV and, at least five years relevant experience in PM or a **RegPM** certification at any level awarded within the last three years. A Member can use the post nominal MAIPM, and can vote at the AGM or in elections.

New members will receive their membership details within 10-14 days following approval of their completed application.

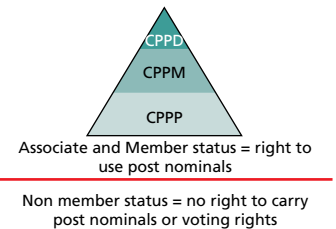
What is a Fellow Member?

A Fellow Member (FAIPM) is an honour provided for exceptional contribution to the PM profession. Fellowship is awarded by the National Council. A Fellow Member can use the post nominal FAIPM and can vote at the AGM.

AIPM Recognition Fee

To make things simpler, there will be one fee for the Review of AIPM Recognition. This fee is \$121. The Review of AIPM Recognition Fee is a charge for AIPM to review your application for initial or higher recognition against the Recognition or RegPM Certification Frameworks (see above).

This fee will apply every time a member wants to be considered for recognition to move a level higher in either framework. Please note that this fee will be charged, irrespective of the outcome of AIPM's review of your status with AIPM.

Are you an Associate Member applying for RegPM Certification?

To encourage Associate Members to upgrade to Member status, AIPM will provide these members with a discount and only charge one Review of Membership Fee (instead of two fees) if an Associate Member also wants to apply for **Reg PM** and Member status at the same time.
