



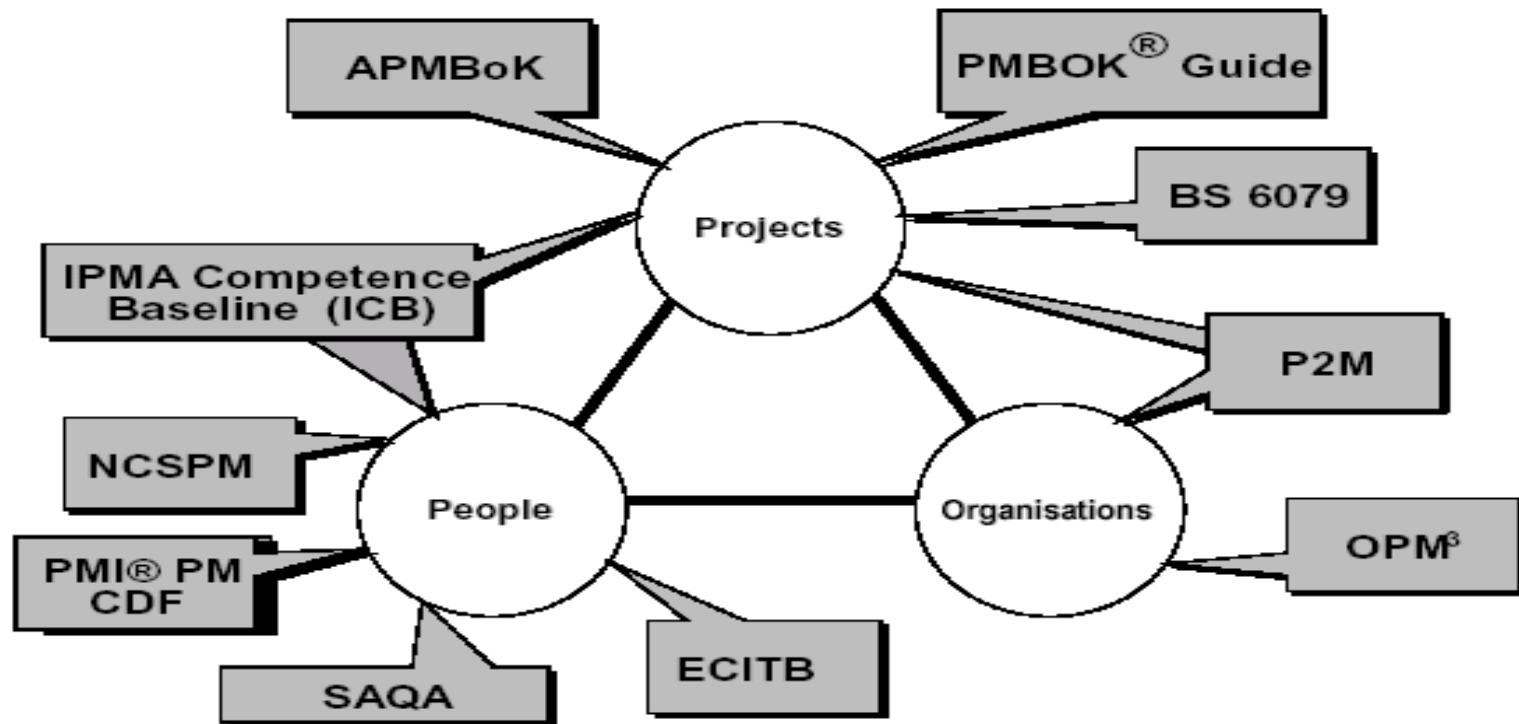

Certification - What is available?

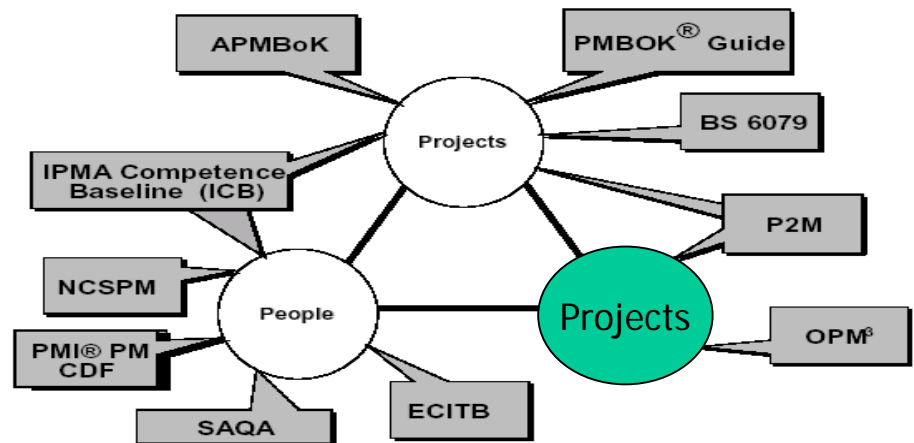


Certification - What is it?

- **Certification** - Used by professional institutes to recognise individuals who have attained a professional standard.
- **Qualification** - a formal level of educational attainment, as determined by a university, TAFE, Registered Training Authority etc).

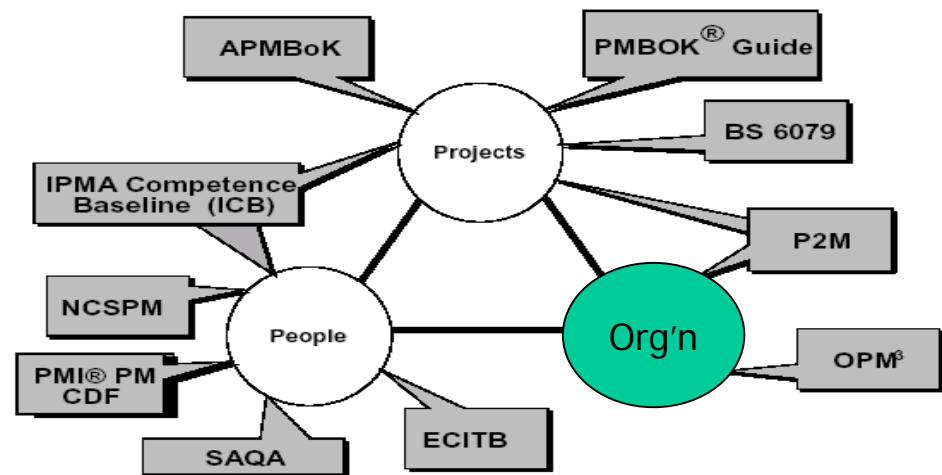
Certification - Projects

- Focussed on describing projects
- Based on some form of Body of Knowledge (eg PMBOK)
- Example - PMI's Project Management Professional (PMP)



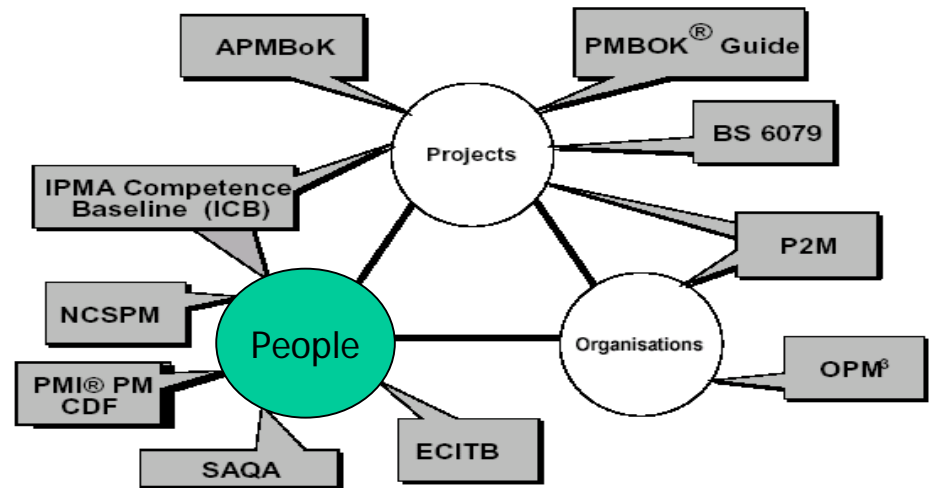
Certification - Organisation

- Focussed on Organisational issues
- Based on some form of methodology
- Example - Prince 2 Practitioner



Certification - People

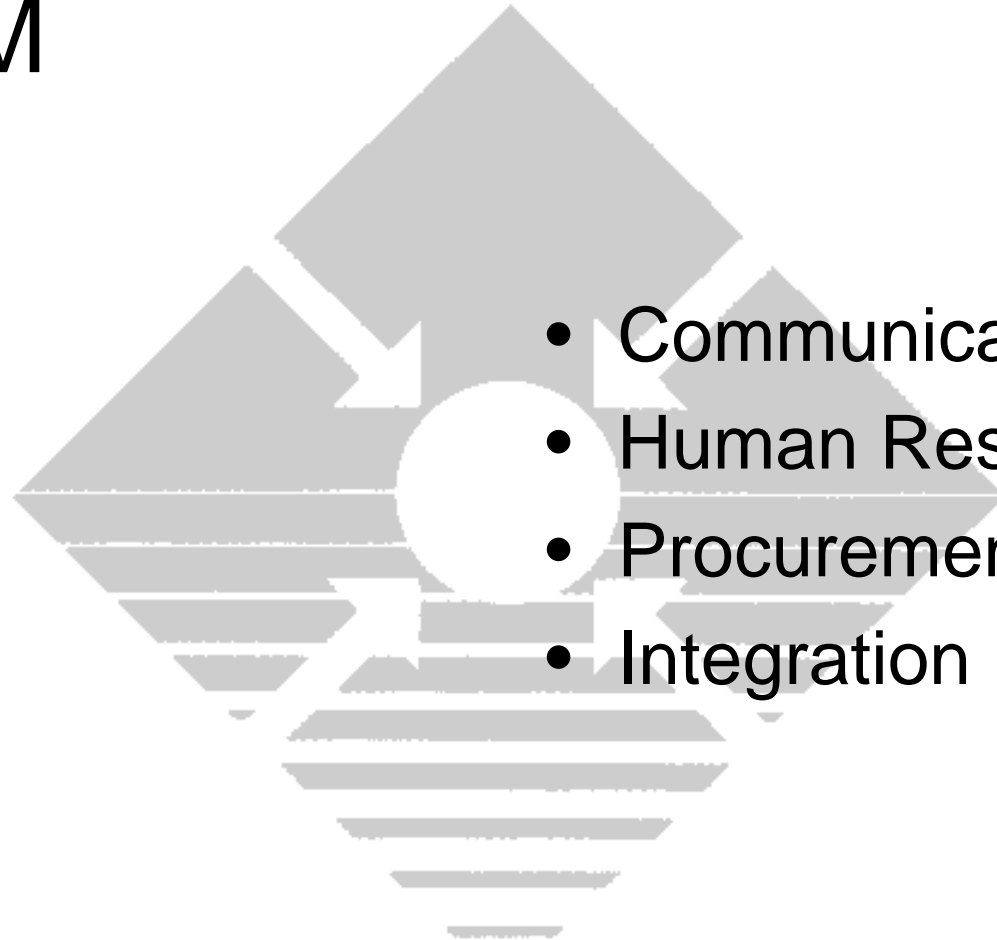
- Focussed on individual competency
- Based on Competency Standards (eg NCSPM)
- Example - AIPM's Registered Project Manager (RegPM)



NCSPM

Covers:

- Scope
- Time
- Cost
- Quality
- Risk
- Communications
- Human Resources
- Procurement
- Integration



What is the RegPM?

- AIPM's certification programme
- Based on the NCSPM
- Workplace-based RCC assessment
- Assesses individual competence
 - skills
 - knowledge
 - attitudes
- 3 Levels

What is the RegPM?

- **Qualified Project Practitioner (QPP)**
 - Project Team Member/Project Specialist
 - Level 4 of NCSPM
 - Supports, assists or contributes to.....
 - may lead to a Cert IV in Project Management

What is the RegPM?

- **Registered Project Manager (RPM)**
 - Project Manager
 - Level 5 of NCSPM
 - Manages
 - may lead to a Diploma in Project Management

What is the RegPM?

- **Master Project Director (MPD)**
 - Project Director/Program Manager
 - Level 6 of NCSPM
 - Directs
 - may lead to an Advanced Diploma in Project Management

Assessment

- Based on:
 - production of evidence
 - demonstrating knowledge
- Conducted by assessors who are:
 - qualified Workplace Assessors
 - qualified in project management
 - endorsed by the AIPM
- To be covered in detail by Gerry

Benefits

- Identify any skills gaps;
- Improve your knowledge, skills and capabilities in project management;
- Gain a competitive advantage over non-Registered Project Managers;
- Gain recognition from the peak body for project management in Australia for your capabilities in project management;

Benefits

- Gain recognition in your organisation for your project management capabilities, in addition to your technical capabilities;
- Identify a path for progressing your career - from project team member to project manager to project director or program manager;
- Inclusion on the Register of Project Managers

Cost

- Members - \$1,100 (inc GST)
